Dear Mr. Dugan:

In accordance with National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians (NREMT) policy, the NREMT has chosen to audit your agency's recertification applications.

Within 30 days, you, as the agency's Training Officer, must return copies of class rosters for following classes held within the last 24 months:

- CPR
- EZIO/IV Training
- Advanced EKG
- Practical Training

These rosters must also include the number of continuing education hours earned for each class. Failure to forward the above-listed documents and their associated hours within 30 days will result in the revocation of certification for your agency's members.

The NREMT will await your documents. Certification is an individual responsibility and not the responsibility of your employer or supervisor, so please make sure you personally forward the documents.
