Dear Ms. Waring,

Thank you for your comittment to excellence and careful review of our records. Our small volunteer (completely unpaid) department went through some major shifts in leadership in Feb/March due to the poor health of our past Captain. You will notice that one of our past training rosters is less professional than we would like it to be as the class went on, with exceptional outside paid instruction, though our captain was not there to provide a more professional looking roster.

There were a few errors on our part that I discovered during this process:

My name should appear on all documentation as April G. Dugan (though I got married last year I have not yet changed my name (on any form of legal ID to Frost.)

CPR-taught by an exceptional outside instructor should be listed as 4 hours of training

IV/EZIO training (also taught by an outside trainer) should be documented as 3.0 hours

Advanced EKG should be 1.0 hours

Practical Training should be listed as 3.5 hours

This leaves Sean Frost short by several hours. He is happy to make these hours up.

Our previous Captain was entering course rosters, so we did not review them before submitting them, as you will see only a couple of the people who attended the training were ever entered into the system. We will correct this, but I wanted to be sure that this was the appropriate action at this time.

I am new to all of this as is our training officer. We hope only to provide exceptional care to our patients and hope that you will be patient with us as we learn this process we were thrown into near the end of our certification process. We apologize for any inconvenience.
